

## Second Model Site Training Scheduled

Twenty-six CASE Model Sites received replication training in February 2006. Due to the success of this training, the Denver District Attorney's Office and the Bureau of Justice Assistance are sponsoring a second Model Site training in Denver in October 8-11, 2006.

The three-day, expense-paid Model Site training includes detailed instruction on starting, funding, marketing and sustaining a prosecutor or law enforcement-community partnership for preventing and prosecuting elder financial exploitation. After attending the February training, all of the Model Site representatives reported they were confident about replicating CASE in their communities.
