TWO CHARGED IN ROOSTER-FIGHTING OPERATION

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has charged two people accused of having a cock-fighting operation in Denver.

Francisco Reyes-Garcia (dob: 07-07-76) and his aunt, **Virginia Casillas-Deluicio** (dob: 08-15-36), are both charged with *animal fighting* (F5) and *aggravated cruelty to animals* (F6).

The case unfolded in late March when a Denver animal control officer on routine patrol discovered what appeared to be a cockfighting operation behind a home in the 4300 block of Milwaukee Street. Thirteen fighting roosters and two brood hens were impounded; one rooster was later euthanized.

Reyes-Garcia has been released from custody on a \$5,000 bond. Casillas-Deluicio has been released from custody on a \$1,000 personal recognizance bond. They are both scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on June 8, 2006 at 9 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
