MAN CHARGED IN ATTACK ON LAW OFFICE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused in a bombing and shooting incident in downtown Denver on Monday.

John Paul Volske (dob: 10-28-36) is charged with *use of an incendiary device* (F2), three counts of *attempted first-degree assault* (F4), *attempted first-degree arson* (F4) and *menacing* (F5).

The charges allege that on May 8, 2006 Volske threw a burning, explosive object into an office at 1921 Market Street and then as he left he pulled a gun and fired shots at two people who were following him.

Volske remains in custody in the Denver County Jail. His bond is set at \$200,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on Tuesday, May 16, 2006 at 9 a.m.
