CHARGES FILED IN COLD CASE HOMICIDE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey formally charged a man yesterday who is accused in the 1990 death of a 36-year-old woman. The body of Paula Joscsak was discovered in the early morning hours of August 7, 1990, in the 1600 block of High Street in Denver.

Corey Bailey (DOB: 11-20-71) is charged with *first-degree murder after deliberation* (F1), *second-degree kidnapping* (F2), two counts of *first-degree aggravated sexual assault* (F2), and *crime of violence* (SE).

The charges allege that Bailey left a party in the 1600 block of High Street and attacked and killed Joscsak, who lived nearby. On August 29th, 2007, detectives with the Denver Police Department's Cold Case Unit identified Corey Bailey as a suspect in Joscsak's murder through a DNA match. He was already in the Denver County Jail for an arrest in July on unrelated charges.

Bailey remains in custody in the Denver County Jail where he is being held without bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on September 10, 2007 at 9 a.m. to be advised of the charges.
