MORE CHARGES FILED IN CISNEROS CASE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged the father of 10-year-old Auralia Cisneros today in connection with her death. An additional co-defendant was also charged yesterday.

Leo (Mickey) Cisneros (dob: 08-21-78) is charged with *child abuse resulting in death* (F2), *possession of marijuana with intent to distribute* (F4) and *possession of more than 8 ounces of marijuana* (F5).

Yesterday, **Christopher Adams** (dob: 09-21-89) was charged with being an *accessory to crime* (F4) and *intimidating a witness* (F4).

Cisneros remains in custody in the Denver County Jail; his bond is set at \$500,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on February 5, 2008 at 9 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.

Adams remains in custody in the Denver County Jail; his bond is set at \$250,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on February 4, 2008 at 9 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
