TWO INDICTED IN DEATH OF HOT DOG VENDOR

A Denver Grand Jury has indicted two men accused in the September 2008 murder of a hot dog vendor in Curtis Park.

Charles K. Ford (dob: 12-30-79) and **DeAngelo Calaway** (dob: 01-29-89) are each charged with *first-degree murder* (F1).

On September 8, 2008, 35-year-old Quincy Henderson was involved in an altercation near 30th and Curtis Streets. The indictment, handed down last week, alleges that a short time later Calaway provided a gun to Ford, who then ran after Henderson and shot him. Henderson died the next day.

Ford was arrested in Georgia and extradited to Colorado last month. Calaway was taken into custody last week in Denver. Both men remain in custody in the Denver County Jail where they are being held without bond.

They are scheduled to appear in Denver District Courtroom 11 on January 8, 2008 at 8:30 a.m. for their arraignment.
