MAN CHARGED IN DATE RAPE DRUG CASE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of buying approximately one gallon of the schedule I drug called GHB, also known as the date-rape drug.

Brian Furer (dob: 11-03-74) is charged with *possession with intent to distribute a schedule I drug* and is also charged with a sentence enhancer of *importation of a schedule I drug*.

The charges allege that Furer ordered and received about a gallon of gamma-hydroxybutyrate on May 30, 2008. Denver police narcotics detectives, acting on a tip, intercepted the shipment and arranged a controlled delivery, after which Furer was taken into custody without incident at his Denver home.

Furer remains in custody in the Denver County Jail; his bond was set at \$250,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on June 6, 2008 at 9 a.m. to be advised of the charges.
