MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO VEHICULAR HOMICIDE

A man accused in the vehicular homicide death of a pedestrian last fall has pleaded guilty in connection with the case.

Christopher Sprout (dob: 10-20-76) was charged in the death of 24-year-old Kevin Watt, whom he hit near Walnut Street and 29th Street while driving drunk after a Rockies game on October 7, 2007.

Sprout, who was scheduled for trial this week, pleaded guilty to vehicular homicide (F4) and careless driving resulting in death (M) last week. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 16, on December 15, 2008 at 1:30 p.m. for sentencing.

The presumptive range for sentencing on a class four felony is two to six years in the Department of Corrections.
