FOURTH MAN CHARGED IN GIRL'S MURDER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a fourth man in connection with the November 26, 2007, shooting death of a 10-year-old girl. The charges are the result of an on-going investigation.

Manuel Talamantes (dob: 01-13-86) is charged with *felony murder* (F1), *attempted aggravated robbery* (F4), and *accessory to crime* (F4).

The charges allege that he was involved with three other co-defendants in trying to commit a robbery when Auralia Cisneros was shot and killed in her home.

Talamantes was arrested last Thursday and remains in custody in the Denver County Jail where he is being held without bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on January 28, 2008, to be advised of the charges.
