MAN CHARGED IN GROCERY STORE STABBING

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man in connection with a stabbing that took place in the parking lot of a grocery store in the early morning hours of October 19, 2009.

Eulalio Chavez (dob: 05-20-76) has been charged with *first-degree assault* (F3) and *attempted first-degree murder* (F2).

The charges allege that Chavez attacked a 31-year-old woman who was a former girlfriend as she walked into work, and then proceeded to stab her numerous times in the body and the face.

Chavez is currently in custody in the Denver County Jail; his bond is set at \$500,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on October 28, 2009 at 9 a.m. to be formally charged.
