MAN CHARGED IN TIRE SLASHING CASE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of slashing the tires of numerous vehicles at Denver fire stations in January.

Glenn Guyman (dob: 03-31-55) is charged with four counts of *criminal mischief* (F4).

The charges allege that on January 18, 2009, Guyman slashed the tires of both city and personal vehicles at fire stations located on Dudley Street, Wolff Street, W. 2nd Avenue and S. Colorado Boulevard, causing thousands of dollars in damage. According to the arrest affidavit, Guyman is a former Denver Fire Department employee who was terminated in 2005.

Guyman has been released from custody on a \$25,000 bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on March 10, 2009 at 9 a.m. to be formally advised.
