MAN POSING AS WORKER CHARGED

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of posing as an official worker to gain entry to a home he then robbed. The robbery occurred last summer.

Frank Chavez (dob: 06-01-81) is charged with two counts of *first-degree burglary* (F3) and two counts of *aggravated robbery* (F3).

The charges allege that on June 4, 2010, Chavez went to a home in the 3300 block of Navajo Street, claimed he needed to check the water, and once inside robbed the residents at gunpoint.

Chavez remains in custody in the Adams County Jail on an unrelated case. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on December 2, 2010 at 10:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.

Denver Water does not conduct random water pressure or quality checks and all Denver Water and city employees carry photo identification cards.
