MAN FOUND GUILTY IN HOME INVASION

A Denver jury has convicted a 41-year-old man in connection with the robbing and kidnapping of a woman in a home invasion robbery.

Darrell Tyrone Guice (dob:07-20-68) was found guilty late yesterday of *aggravated robbery* (F3), *first-degree burglary* (F3), two counts of *kidnapping* (F2 and F3) and *aggravated motor vehicle theft* (F5).

On June 16, 2008, Guice confronted a 62-year-old woman as she was coming out of her home, forced her back inside, held her against her will while ransacking her home and then fled in her car. Denver police were able to identify Guice as a suspect within a few days and he was arrested four days later.

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey and Chief Deputy District Attorney Adrienne Greene prosecuted the case.

Guice remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center. He is scheduled to be sentenced July 12, 2010, at 1:30 p.m. in Denver District Courtroom 17. He faces up to 83 years in prison.
