MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO RACKETEERING CHARGE

A Denver businessman who faced multiple criminal counts has pleaded guilty in Denver District Court today.

Mark J. Jackson (dob: 09-09-54) pleaded guilty to *violating the Colorado Organized Crime Control Act* (F2).

Beginning in 1995 Jackson portrayed himself as a successful day trader and took money from investors with promises of returns from 12 to 36 percent. Instead of investing the money, Jackson used it to pay other investors and also used investor money for his personal benefit. Victim losses of both principle and interest are estimated to be in the millions of dollars.

Jackson faces from probation to 20 years in the Denver Department of Corrections when he is sentenced on May 25, 2010 at 1:30.
