FORMER OFFICER SENTENCED IN HARASSMENT CASE

Damon Bolden (dob: 07-05-64), a former Denver police officer, pleaded guilty to harassment (M3) and was sentenced today. In exchange for his guilty plea he was given a two-year supervised deferred judgment, he was required to resign from the Denver Police Department, must attend anger management classes, and can have no contact with the victim. The guilty plea will also result in the loss of Bolden's P.O.S.T. certification (Peace Officer Standards Training).

Bolden was accused of leaving threatening, harassing telephone voice mail messages for a woman on her answering machine in November 2005. He resigned from the police department earlier this month.
