CULP SENTENCED

A man who killed a Denver couple in October 2004 by causing a horrific traffic crash has been sentenced today. He pleaded guilty earlier to criminally negligent homicide.

Fredrick Culp was sentenced to 30 months in prison, but that sentence was suspended on the condition that he successfully complete 4 years of supervised probation, perform 250 hours of community service and that he maintains a full-time job or full-time enrollment in school (or combination of the two). He is also prohibited from driving a vehicle.

Culp was driving at a high rate of speed in the Belcaro neighborhood on October 3, 2004 when he broadsided a car, killing 85-year-old Clinton Anderson and 83-year-old Sophie Anderson.

Culp will begin serving the sentence once he completes a current jail term on another case.
