MAN CHARGED IN MOTHER'S MURDER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has charged a 63-year-old man who is accused of murdering his own mother. Her body was found in an apartment they shared after neighbors complained of a bad odor.

Donald "Marty" Currier (dob: 02-19-43) is charged with *first-degree murder* (F1).

The charge alleges that Currier shot and killed his mother, 86-year-old Mary Currier, sometime between April 21, 2006 and May 4, 2006. Her body was found May 4, 2006 by building maintenance workers who were investigating reports of an odor. Currier was arrested by Denver police detectives on June 14, 2006 at a bar when he allegedly tried to use his mother's credit card.

Currier is being held without bond in the Denver County Jail. He is scheduled to be formally advised of the charge on June 22, 2006 at 9 a.m. Denver County Court, room 12T.
