WOMAN CHARGED WITH MURDER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has charged a 33-year-old woman in connection with a shooting that left a 26-year-old man dead just over a week ago.

Terrina Flora-Alexander (DOB: 07-05-79) is charged with *first-degree murder* (F1).

The charge alleges that Flora-Alexander shot and killed Antwan Dawkins on October 1, 2006 at about 3:30 in the alley in the 3000 block of Humbolt Street. Denver police arrested her a short time later in the 2800 block of Downing. It's believed she had been involved in an altercation with the victim earlier in the day.

Flora-Alexander remains in custody in the Denver County Jail, where she is being held without bond. She will be formally advised of the charges on October 11, 2006 at 9:00 a.m. in the Denver County Court, room 12T.
