CHARGES FILED IN SCRAP METAL THEFT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged six people in connection with a burglary at the site of the old Gates Rubber Plant last week.

Robert D. Bordas (DOB: 08-18-59), **Kevin D. McGarry** (DOB: 10-22-55), **Scott T. Harold** (DOB: 07-17-62), **Rebekah G. Miller** (DOB: 02-21-76), **Shannon E. Vicenec** (DOB: 04-04-88) and **Joshua M. Welles** (DOB: 11-30-81) are each charged with *felony theft* (F-4), *felony criminal mischief* (F-4) and *felony burglary* (F-4).

Denver Police officers responded to 1001 S. Broadway on April 12, 2006 on a report of a burglary in progress. The charges allege that they were stealing scrap metal and other valuables from the vacant building.

McGarry, whose bond was set at \$5,000, and Harold, whose bond was set at \$10,000, remain in custody and will be advised of the charges on April 19, 2006 in Denver County Court, room 12T. Bordas, Vicenec, and Welles have been released on bond and will be advised of charges on April 26, 2006. Miller is out on bond and will be advised of the charges on April 27, 2006.
