'94 MURDER SOLVED – CHARGES FILED

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of murdering a woman in 1994, the result of a successful investigation by Denver police homicide detectives.

Donald Hicks (04-07-60) is charged with *first-degree murder* (F1).

The charge alleges that on March 2, 1994 Hicks beat a woman to death in a Denver motel. The victim was 32-year-old Susan Lundy.

Detectives with the Denver Police Department Homicide Unit identified Hicks as a suspect and recently learned that he had been arrested in Boise, Idaho. A warrant for his arrest has been issued and the formal murder charge was filed on April 28, 2006.
