WOMAN CHARGED WITH INTIMIDATING A WITNESS

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a woman in connection with threatening telephone calls made to a victim in a pending criminal case.

Kimaya James (DOB: 10-09-80) is charged with two counts of *intimidating a witness* (F4).

The charges allege that on the evening of December 3, 2006 James made two telephone calls to the victim, Kalonniann Clark, trying to convince her not to testify against Brian Hicks, the man suspected of shooting at Clark last year. Clark was murdered on December 6, 2006; the homicide is still being investigated.

James is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on Wednesday, December 20, 2006 at 9 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
