MAN CHARGED IN CAR BREAK-IN CASE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man who was arrested at a lower downtown parking garage last week following an officer-involved shooting.

Devon Kelly (dob: 04-15-82) is charged with *first-degree criminal trespass* (F5).

The charge alleges that Kelly was breaking into cars in a parking garage at 699 W. 29th Avenue in the early morning hours of April 20, 2006. A second suspect in the break-ins, Jimmy Orozco (dob: 09-27-82), sped toward officers in a car in an attempt to run them over and was shot. He later died.

Kelly remains in custody in the Denver County Jail. His bond is set at \$15,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, at 9 a.m. on April 28, 2006 to be advised of the charge.
