The woman accused of orchestrating a drive-by shooting that left two young girls with gunshot

wounds last summer has pleaded guilty in Denver District Court today.

Natalie McFarlane (dob: 01-25-86) pleaded guilty to first-degree assault in the August 2005

shooting of two sisters who were sleeping in their bed when they were shot and injured. It happened

near First Avenue and Osceola.
