FORMAL CHARGES AGAINST OFFICER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a suspended police officer in connection with an on-duty incident that occurred March 5, 2006.

Adam Nuanez (dob: 08-31-71) is charged with *first-degree criminal trespass (F5)*, *first-degree official misconduct (M2)*, *official oppression (M2)* and *harassment (M3)*.

Nuanez was on-duty March 5, 2006 when he and other officers responded to a motel at 3050 W. 49th Avenue and contacted a woman. The charges allege that Nuanez, still on-duty and still in uniform, returned a short time later outside the scope of his official responsibilities and harassed the woman.

Nuanez has been released from custody on a \$3,000 and is scheduled to be formally advised of the charges on June 27, 2006 at 9 a.m. in Denver County Court, room 12T.
