FATHER CHARGED IN CHILD ABUSE CASE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has charged a 21-year-old father with child abuse after his two-month old son was rushed to a local hospital last weekend.

Quentin Brown (dob: 05-13-85) is charged with *child abuse resulting in serious bodily injury* (F3).

The charge alleges that on April 8, 2007 at about 7 a.m. Brown injured his son by shaking him in an attempt to get the child to stop crying.

Brown remains in custody in the Denver County Jail. His bond is set at \$25,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court on Tuesday, April 17, 2007 at 9 a.m. to be formally advised of the charge.

The presumptive range for sentencing on a class 3 felony is up to 12 years in prison.
