CHARGES FILED IN BABY DEATH

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a father in the death of his infant daughter. 3-month-old Aideli Cardoza wasn't breathing when a grandparent found her on January 16, 2007. She was taken to an area hospital but died a short time later.

Jose Antonio Cardoza-Soria (dob: 04-21-81) is charged with *first-degree murder* (F1) and *child abuse resulting in death* (F2).

The charges allege that Cardoza-Soria was caring for his daughter on January 16th and caused the injuries that led to her death.

He remains in custody in the Denver County Jail where he is being held without bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court on January 25, 2007 at 9 a.m. to be advised of the charges.

He faces life in prison without the possibility of parole if convicted of first-degree murder.
