TWO MEN CHARGED IN ATTACK ON 'FRIENDS'

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged two young men accused of attacking two young women who were considered friends.

Joshua Cordova (dob: 07-06-82) is charged with *sexual assault* (F2) and *first-degree assault* (F3).

Jeffrey Dominguez (dob: 12-02-84) is charged with *sexual assault* (F2) and *accessory to crime* (F5).

Dominguez and a 21-year-old woman had come up to Denver from Pueblo on February 4, 2007 to visit Cordova and a 28-year-old woman. The charges allege that Dominguez and Cordova sexually assaulted the 21-year-old woman and that Cordova shot and injured the 28-year-old woman.

Both men remain in custody in the Denver County Jail; their bond is set at \$100,000. They are scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on February 15, 2007 at 9 a.m. to be advised of the charges.
