DOBSON PLEADS GUILTY IN SNOWMOBILE SHOWDOWN

An off-duty Denver police officer who pointed his gun at a neighbor earlier this year has pleaded guilty in connection with the case today.

Christopher Dobson (dob: 09-30-60) pleaded guilty to one count of *prohibited use of a weapon* (M2). In exchange for the guilty plea, the original count of menacing (F5) was dismissed.

The guilty plea agreement included a requirement that Dobson resign from the Denver Police Department by tomorrow, September 14, 2007.

Dobson will be sentenced on September 28, 2007 at 1:30 p.m. He faces probation up to 12 months in the Denver County Jail.

The altercation occurred on January 3, 2007 following a snowstorm as the victim was riding a snowmobile along West College Avenue in Denver near Dobson's home.
