BEER BURGLAR SENTENCED FOR TRESPASS

A man accused of breaking into a Denver home, drinking the victim's beer and other unusual behavior appeared in Denver District Court for sentencing today.

Glenn House (10-27-70) was sentenced to 2 years in the Colorado Department of Corrections for first-degree criminal trespass (F5) but the sentence was suspended pending the successful completion of a 3-year intensive outpatient treatment program. House was originally charged with second-degree burglary and criminal trespass; the burglary charge was dismissed in exchange for his guilty plea.

House broke into a home in June by climbing through an open kitchen window. He took a beer from the home's refrigerator and a clean shirt from the dryer before he was caught by the homeowner.
