### **MAN CONVICTED OF "COLD CASE" SEXUAL ASSAULT**

A man accused in the 1992 rape of a mother and daughter has been found guilty on all charges today. A Denver jury returned the verdict after about two hours of deliberation.

**LC Jackson** (dob: 09-16-66) was convicted of four counts of *sexual assault* (F2), *sexual assault on a child* (F3) and *second-degree kidnapping* (F3) along with a sentence-enhancing count of *crime of violence*. He was also convicted of being an habitual criminal.

The charges alleged that Jackson broke into the victims' home in the 3600 block of Columbine Street in August 1992 and sexually assaulted a 42-year-old woman and her 9-year-old daughter at knifepoint. Detectives were unable to identify a suspect at the time. The case was reviewed as part of Denver's DNA Cold Case Project and Jackson was identified as a suspect through a DNA match. Jackson was in the Colorado Department of Corrections and was scheduled to be released on parole just days before being charged in the '92 assaults.

He is scheduled to appear in Denver District Court on August 20, 2007 at 1:30 to be sentenced.
