PARENTS CHARGED IN METH LAB CASE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged two parents in connection with a suspected meth lab operation in Denver.

Aaron Neal (dob: 09-06-72) and **Kimberly Angelo-Neal** (dob: 12-30-74) are each charged with six counts of *child abuse* (F3) and six different felony drug counts (F3 and F4) including *manufacture of a controlled substance, conspiracy to manufacture a controlled substance, possession of chemical supplies, possession of precursor material*, and possession of a controlled substance. Aaron Neal also faces one count of fourth-degree arson (F4).

The charges allege that Neal and Angelo-Neal were operating a meth lab in their home in the 3100 block of Umatilla Street while caring for their 1-year daughter. The charges further allege that the lab caught fire in the early morning hours of July 18, 2007.

Neal and Angelo-Neal remain in custody in the Denver County Jail. Their bond is set at \$50,000 each. They are scheduled to be advised of the charges in Denver County Court, room 12T, on August 1, 2007 at 9 a.m.
