CHARGES FILED IN ROBBERY AT MARKET

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of shooting a storekeeper during a robbery last week.

Patrick Perez (dob: 11-04-87) is charged with two counts of *attempted first-degree murder* (F2), *attempted aggravated robbery* (F4) and *first-degree assault* (F3).

The charges allege that Perez tried to rob the Third Avenue Market on September 27, 2007 and that during the robbery he shot and wounded one storekeeper then physically assaulted another before fleeing the scene.

Perez remains in custody in the Denver County Jail. His bond is set at \$200,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on October 5, 2007 at 9 a.m. to be advised of the charges.

*The filing of a criminal charge is merely a formal accusation that an individual(s) committed a crime(s) under Colorado laws. A defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty. *See* Colo. RPC 3.6
