FORMAL CHARGES FILED AGAINST RANDELL IN REVENUE THEFT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of helping steal millions of dollars from the Colorado Department of Revenue.

Hysear Randell (DOB: 03-03-67) is charged with 24 felony counts including violating the Colorado Organized Crime Control Act (F2), two counts of conspiracy to commit computer crime (F4), theft (F4), conspiracy to commit theft (F4), eighteen counts of forgery (F5), and conspiracy to commit embezzlement of public property (F6).

Randell remains in custody in the Denver County Jail. His bond is set at \$10,000,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on Tuesday, May 8, 2007 at 9 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
