COOPERATIVE EFFORT LEADS TO SUSPECT'S ARREST

Hysear Randell (DOB: 03-03-67) was arrested this afternoon near I-25 and Colfax Avenue thanks to the cooperative work of numerous law enforcement agencies.

The search for Randell has been underway since Friday, April 27th when a warrant was issued for his arrest for investigation of theft. Randell is suspected of participating in a scheme to steal millions of dollars from Colorado's Department of Revenue.

Representatives of the following agencies and task forces have conducted surveillance and gathered investigative information over the last several days and are credited with Randell's arrest today:

The US Marshal's Office, the FBI, the Fugitive Location and Apprehension Group (FLAG) which is made up of numerous local, state and federal law enforcement representatives, the Larimer County Sheriff's Department, the Weld County Sheriff's Department and the Denver Police Department.

Randell was a passenger in a rented Cadillac Escalade that was pulled over this afternoon on I-25 at about Colfax Avenue. He was taken into custody without incident. The driver of the vehicle and another passenger, who have not been identified at this time, were detained for questioning.
