MAN CHARGED WITH ATTEMPTED MURDER OF CLERK

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of shooting a convenience store clerk on the 16th Street Mall over the weekend .

Broderick Roddy (dob: 01-12-85) is charged with *attempted first-degree murder* (F2).

The charge alleges Roddy was responsible for the shooting of store clerk Ali Bashir Abu Zama following an altercation within the store on Sunday afternoon, August 12, 2007.

Roddy remains in custody in the Denver County Jail; his bond is set at \$100,000. He is scheduled to be formally advised of the charge in Denver County Court, room 12T, on August 16, 2007 at 9 a.m..
