THREE CHARGED IN SHOOTING DEATH OF GIRL

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged three young men in connection with the November 26, 2007, shooting death of 10-year-old Auralia Cisneros.

Trivi Trujillo (dob: 04-16-88), **Joshua Rojas** (dob: 11-03-88), and **Juvenico Hernandez** (dob: 01-14-88) are charged with one count each of *felony murder* (F1).

The charges allege that the defendants were trying to commit robbery when the little girl was shot and killed in her home.

All three defendants remain in custody in the Denver County Jail where they are being held without bond. They are scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on December 19, 2007, to be advised of the charges.
