MAN FOUND GUILTY IN BAR SHOOTING

A Denver jury has convicted a man accused of shooting at bar patrons as they left a lower downtown nightclub. Four people were shot and wounded in November 2005.

Michael Rollie (dob: 07-30-70) was found guilty of one count of *attempted first-degree murder*, three counts of *attempted manslaughter*, three counts of *first-degree assault* and one count of *second-degree assault*.

Rollie was involved in an altercation inside Market 41 at about 1:50 a.m. on November 24, 2005 in which he was injured by a glass bottle that hit him on the head. He left the bar and a few minutes later began firing shots along Market Street, hitting four people. One of victims of the shooting has since passed away.

Rollie will be sentenced on December 18, 2007 at 8:30 a.m. in Denver District Courtroom 16.
