MAN CHARGED IN BANK ROBBERY, BURGLARY AND CAR THEFT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has filed formal charges against a man accused of robbing a bank and leading police on both a car chase and foot chase before being taken into custody last week.

Wayne Rose (dob: 07-31-72) faces nine charges including *first-degree kidnapping* (F2), *first-degree burglary* (F3), *second-degree burglary* (F4), two counts of *aggravated robbery* (F3), *aggravated motor vehicle theft* (F4), two counts of *menacing* (F5) and *eluding a police officer* (T2).

The charges allege that Rose robbed at a bank at 5901 E. Colfax Avenue on June 26, 2007. He allegedly fled the bank on foot and menaced two residents who followed him into a nearby neighborhood. The charges further allege Rose robbed another victim of his car then led police on a brief car chase. He then allegedly abandoned the car and was chased on foot by an officer when the two were hit by a police car; Rose was then taken into custody. Rose was treated for minor injuries at Denver Health Medical Center and is currently in custody in the Denver County Jail. His bond is set at \$125,000.

Rose is scheduled to appear in Denver District Court to be formally advised of the charges on July 5th, 2007 at 9 a.m. in Denver County Court, room 12T.
