ERIC SNELL PLEADS GUILTY

Eric Snell (dob: 05-12-71) pleaded guilty today to three counts of *accessory to crime – vehicular homicide* (F5) and one count of *DUI*.

Snell's plea arose out of his role in the November 10, 2006 collision that took the lives of Rebecca Bingham, and her two children Garrison and Macie. Her husband Frank Bingham was also seriously injured. The DUI charge arose out of conduct that occurred several hours later.

Sentencing will be in courtroom 12 on August 24, 2007 at 1:30.
