MAN CHARGED WITH VEHICULAR HOMICIDE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has charged a man accused of hitting a pedestrian while driving drunk after a Rockies game on October 7, 2007.

Christopher Sprout (dob: 10-20-76) is charged with *vehicular homicide* (F3)

The charge alleges that Sprout was driving drunk at Walnut Street and 29th Street at about 1 a.m. when he struck and killed 24-year-old Kevin Watt.

Sprout has been released from custody on a \$25,000 bond and is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on October 22, 2007 at 9 a.m. to be formally advised of the charge.
