THREE MEN CHARGED WITH CRIMINAL MISCHIEF AFTER ROCKIES GAME

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged three men in connection with criminal mischief after a Rockies Championship game.

Manuel Tapia (DOB: 03-25-1985) is charged with *criminal mischief* (F4) and *escape* (F4).

Gregory Georgeson (DOB 10-14-1982) is charged with *criminal mischief* (F4).

Stephen Polk (DOB: 10-02-1982) is charged with *criminal mischief* (F4) and *escape* (F4).

The charges allege that just shortly after midnight on October 16, 2007, the three men jumped on a Denver Police patrol car on the corner of 20th and Blake Street in lower downtown causing nearly \$3,500 in damage. All three have been released on bond and will appear in court for their advisements within the next two weeks.

The presumptive range for sentencing on a class 4 felony is up to 6 years in prison.
