SUSPECTED SERIAL BURGLAR CHARGED

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has filed formal charges against a man accused of breaking into multiple homes and stealing women's undergarments and other personal items.

Carlos Vigil (dob: 05-06-73) is charged with seven counts of *second-degree burglary* (F3) in three separate cases.

The charges allege that Vigil, dubbed the "Panty Burglar" by investigators, broke into numerous homes in the area of 44th and Federal in northwest Denver, often through open windows and doggie doors. The charges further allege that Vigil removed clothing and personal photographs from the homes before fleeing.

Vigil has been released from custody on a \$75,000 bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on June 28, 2007 at 9 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
