CHARGES FILED AGAINST BROTHERS IN MARIJUANA CULTIVATION CASE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged two brothers with possessing and cultivating marijuana with the intent to distribute. More than seventeen pounds of marijuana was accidentally discovered in a home in the 4500 block of West 38th Avenue after a car crashed into the side of the house revealing the marijuana operation.

Eduardo Vigil (dob: 2-14-1946) and **Miguel Vigil** (dob: 1-22-1953) are charged with *cultivation of marijuana* (F4) and *possession with intent to distribute marijuana* (F4).

The charges allege that on January 10, 2007, an unrelated driver lost control on the ice and crashed into the Vigil home. When officers arrived at the scene, damage to the home revealed marijuana plants in plain view; nearly one hundred plants and growing equipment were eventually confiscated from the residence.

Both men have been released from custody on bond. They are scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on January 26, 2007, at 9 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
