MAN CHARGED WITH SEXUAL ASSAULT AT CRESTMOOR DOWNS

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of kidnapping a woman from her parking garage and sexually assaulting her before driving to a 7-Eleven and forcing the victim to withdraw money from an ATM.

David Preston (dob: 12-06-84) is charged with *first-degree kidnapping* (F1), *sexual assault* (F2), *sexual assault* (F3), and *aggravated robbery* (F3).

The charges allege Preston was responsible for sexually assaulting a woman in her parking garage near Crestmoor Downs before driving her car to a nearby neighborhood for further sexual assault. Preston then allegedly drove the victim to 7-Eleven, forcing her to withdraw funds from the ATM and proceeded to take the money.

Preston remains in custody in the Denver County Jail and his bond is set at \$500,000. He is scheduled to be formally advised of the charges in Denver District Courtroom 12 Friday, August 24, 2007, at 8:30 a.m.
