MAN FOUND GUILTY OF FIRST-DEGREE MURDER, SENTENCED

A Denver jury has convicted a man of first-degree murder; accused of confronting his wife's lover and then shooting him to death last year.

Mustafa Ujaama (DOB: 02-09-68) was found guilty of *first-degree murder* (F1) and *aggravated motor vehicle theft* (F3) earlier today.

On July 12, 2006, Mustafa Ujaama lured the victim, Timothy Kaufman to his home in the 2800 block of Dexter Street. Ujaama then shot and killed the victim and put his body in the trunk of the victim's car. He then stole the car and later abandoned it. The victim was discovered the next day and Ujaama subsequently surrendered himself to police.

Ujaama's conviction of first-degree murder carries a mandatory life sentence, which was imposed today after the jury's verdict.
