MAN CHARGED IN CRASH THAT KILLED CAB DRIVER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has filed formal charges against a 21-year-old man from Aurora who is accused of crashing into a cab while driving drunk, killing the cab driver.

Darian Blackwell (dob: 05-22-87) is charged with two counts of *vehicular homicide* (F3 and F4).

The charges allege that about 1:30 a.m. on September 6, 2008, Blackwell was driving northbound on Williams Street under the influence of alcohol when he went through a stop sign at 18th Avenue at a high rate of speed. The charges further allege that he crashed into a cab that was westbound on 18th Avenue, killing the driver, 32-year-old Solomon Abraham.

Blackwell remains in custody in the Denver County Jail. His bond is set at \$75,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, at 9 a.m. on September 11, 2008 to be advised of the charges.
