INDICTMENT HANDED DOWN IN DARRENT WILLIAMS' MURDER

A Denver Grand Jury returned a 39-count indictment today charging a man in the murder of Darrent Williams and the attempted murder of two others.

Willie D. Clark (dob: 05-16-83) is charged with two counts of first-degree murder (F1), sixteen counts of attempted first-degree murder (F2), two counts of second-degree assault (F4), illegal discharge of a firearm (F5), sixteen crime of violence counts (sentence enhancer), and two counts of possession of a weapon by a previous offender (F6).

The charges allege that about 2:15 a.m. on January 1, 2007, Clark, who was driving a sport utility vehicle, pulled along side a limousine in the area of Speer Boulevard and 11th Avenue and fired multiple gunshots into the vehicle.

There were 16 passengers in the limousine in addition to the driver. One of those passengers, 24-year-old Darrent Williams, was killed. Two other passengers were wounded.

Clark is currently in federal custody. His next court appearance will be scheduled in Denver District Court sometime next week.

He faces life in prison without parole if convicted of the charges.
