MAN CHARGED IN 2004 MURDER

A Denver Grand Jury returned an indictment last week against a man accused of murder in the 2004 disappearance and death of 45-year-old Timothy Ware.

Charles Dean (dob: 05-02-59) is charged by indictment with one count of first-degree murder.

Dean and the victim were friends, and the indictment alleges that in October 2004 Dean killed Ware in Ware's home at 3350 Krameria Street. The indictment further alleges that Dean disposed of the body and set Ware's home on fire.

The indictment was issued on July 23, 2008 and Dean was arrested two days later. He is being held in custody in the Denver County Jail without bond. He is scheduled for arraignment on August 7, 2008 in Denver District Courtroom 11 at 8:30 a.m.
