CHARGES FILED IN '05 HALLOWEEN MURDERS

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man wanted in connection with the 2005 murders of 21-year-old Teddy Guerra and 21-year-old Isaiah Roybal.

Rodolfo Gonzales (dob: 05-30-80) is charged with two counts of *first-degree murder* (F1) and one count of *attempted first-degree murder* (F2).

The charges allege that Gonzales participated in a shooting at a Halloween party in 2005 that left Guerra and Roybal dead and seriously injured a third man.

Gonzales was arrested earlier this week in California under an alias in an unrelated drug case. Police in Redondo Beach identified him through fingerprints and found he was wanted in Denver for a 2003 assault case and the 2005 murder case.

Gonzales remains in custody in California pending extradition.
