MAN CHARGED IN HOME INVASION

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has charged a man accused of robbing and kidnapping a woman in a home invasion robbery.

Darrell Tyrone Guice (dob: 07-20-68) is charged with *aggravated robbery* (F3), *first-degree burglary* (F3), two counts of *kidnapping* (F2 and F3) and *aggravated motor vehicle theft* (F5).

The charges allege that on June 16, 2008 Guice confronted a 62-year-old woman as she was coming out of her home, forced her back inside, held her against her will while ransacking her home and then fled in her car. Denver Police detectives identified Guice as a suspect within a few days and took him into custody June 20, 2008.

Guice remains in custody in the Denver County Jail. His bond is set at \$250,000. He is set to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, at 9 a.m. on June 26, 2008 to be formally advised of the charges.
